Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. No AAU or All-Start Teams. Players must be from the same school district.
2. Unless specified below, all WIAA rules apply.
3. WIAA certified officials will be used for all games.
4. Decisions of the officials and tournament committee are final.
5. Technical fouls will be an automatic two points and possession of the ball. Team or player un-sportsmanlike technical fouls may result in an automatic ejection from the game and forfeiture of all awards and registration fees.
6. Roster limit: There will be no cap on the roster size; however, a maximum of 15 awards will be given.
7. Teams must supply their own numbered jerseys and practice balls.
8. **Pressing:** 7th and 8th grade may press any time. However, a team leading by a score of 10 points or more must take off the press. 3rd - 6th grade may press only in the final 2 minutes of the 2nd half or overtime.
9. **Defense:** 7th and 8th grade any defense. 3rd - 6th grade no Zone defense.
10. **Time-Outs:** One full and two thirty second timeouts per game. In overtime, each team will receive one full timeout. Timeouts do NOT carryover from regulation to overtime
11. **Games** will consist of two 18 minute halves with running clock. Clock will stop on all dead balls in the final 2 minutes of both halves unless there is a 20 point differential in the 2nd half. After a 20 point differential is met the clock will not stop. **Overtime** will be 2 minutes with the clock stopping on all dead balls.
12. If the game remains tied following an overtime period, free throws will determine a winner. The 5 players on the floor at the final buzzer will each shoot one free throw alternating teams. Coin toss: team that wins coin toss will decide to shoot first or second, then other team will pick the basket they want to shoot at. Teams will shoot at opposite baskets.
13. Intentional misuse or damage to the facility in any way will result in an ejection from the grounds and the responsible party(s) will be liable for all damages incurred.
